Funds recovered from the sale of forfeiture items are distributed among the participating agencies. The Department uses their share of these federal funds to purchase technological supplies and equipment for the Counter Drug Support Program.

Project Description/Justification:

The Alaska National Guard (ANG) Counterdrug Support Program (CDSP) currently assists law enforcement agencies which participate in an investigation or prosecution that results in a federal forfeiture, and qualifies to receive a share of the federal funds when forfeiture situations occur. These funds will be receipted and expended in accordance with the U.S. Department of Justice's (USDOJ) guidance, "A Guide to Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies". State expenditure of these funds will be made in the area of technological support supplies for this program. Examples of which would be radio equipment and various counterdrug activity commodities.
