

GOVERNOR'S NORTH STAR AWARDS FOR INTERNATIONAL EXCELLENCE NOMINATION OUTLINE



Nominations consist of no more than five pages of material and should explain the accomplishments and success of the international activities that have occurred in the five-year period 2003 to 2007. Brochures, photos and other materials count as part of the five pages. The first page should be labeled "Nomination for Governor's North Star Awards for International Excellence," and include the following information.

1. Name, address, and website (if applicable) of company, organization, or individual being nominated.
2. Name and title of chief executive (if applicable).
3. Name, email, and phone of contact person.
4. Area of excellence.

Specify one or more of the categories listed below in which the nomination should be considered.

- Trade – Export of Goods
- Trade – Export of Services
- Foreign Investment
- Tourism
- Transportation
- Education
- Cultural Exchange
- Humanitarian Exchange
- Scientific Exchange

5. Description of excellence.

Use the remaining space in the five pages to describe the international activity in detail. Describe goals and how the achievements have benefited Alaska. Provide numbers that quantify the activity. For instance, some of the following may help to illustrate the value of the activity to Alaska: number of Alaskans involved in enterprise or activity; knowledge gained or transferred; new international markets or programs developed; expansion of existing international markets or programs; length of history in Alaska; dollar volume of exports, services or investment; number of new jobs generated in the state.
